ABOUT THE STUDY

The City of Albuquerque, in partnership with the Mid-Region Council of Governments (MRCOG), is conducting a **Complete Streets Study** on Taylor Ranch Road/Golf Course Road to identify the specific safety issues and challenges faced by pedestrians, bicyclists, and transit riders along the corridor.

The principal goals of the study are to document **existing conditions** along the corridor, **identify safety concerns** and **gaps** in the pedestrian and bicycle networks, present recommendations for **roadway improvements**, as well as recommend **character enhancements** along the corridor.

PURPOSE OF MEETING

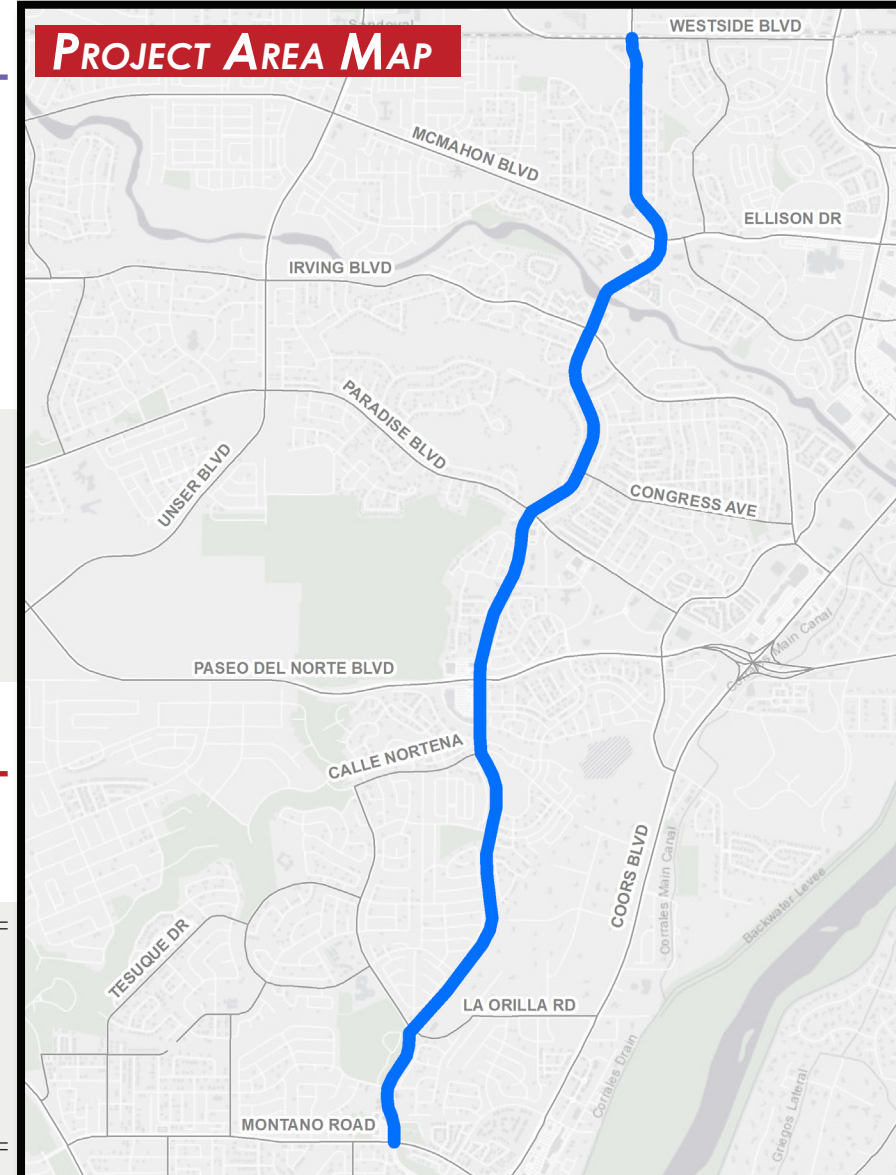
