## **PAINT COLOR POLICY**

## Established by the Board/ACC December 2012

## Section 8.02: Construction of Improvements

a. states:

".... and before anyone shall paint, texture, repaint or retexture the exterior surfaces of any Improvement, there shall be submitted to the Architectural Control Committee plans and specifications...."

(1) states;

".... shall enable the Committee to evaluate whether the proposed construction, alteration, installation, etc. will <u>harmonize with the motif and style of the</u> <u>Subdivision</u> and be compatible with surrounding homes:..."

b. states:

"The [Architectural Control] Committee shall have the right and power to disapprove .... if a design or color scheme submitted is not in harmony and accord with the Subdivision, or surrounding homes...."

## Section 8.03: Design Guidelines

2. States:

"The exterior finish of homes must be principally stucco, the principal color of which shall be earth tones or muted pastels."

Earth tones are the colors initially used for the homes. Pastels are colors to which white is added to the original color to form a pastel. Additional white is then added to pastels to make the color lighter, softer [more washed out] and is termed a muted pastel.
